



WHIST RULES & REGULATIONS FOR 2024

WHIST COMPETITION – RULES & REGULATIONS

1. There are two sets of score cards – Blue score cards and yellow score cards
2. Each table should have two blue score cards and two yellow score cards. Each player should always play with a partner of the opposite score card color. That is a blue score card holder should partner with a yellow score card holder, and they should play against a blue score cardholder partnering with a yellow score card holder.
3. Movement of a player after each game shall be conducted as follows –
 - Blue score card holder winner shall move one table number up.
 - Yellow score card holder winner shall move one table number down.
 - Blue score card holder loser shall move one seat to the right.
 - Yellow score card holder loser shall stay on the same seat.
4. Each trick (hath) a team makes is equal to one (1) point per individual in that team. Any team that scores ten (10) or more points should get their card signed by an official before moving to the next game.
5. Sirs/jokers/trump shall be announced by the game master at each game and is only valid for that game. No sir/jokers/trump shall be made by any player for the game unless informed otherwise.
6. No talking or showing ANY sorts of signs shall be allowed during the period a game is played. ANY player found either talking and/or showing any signs shall be awarded zero (0) points for that player and his/her partner and a total of twelve (12) points shall be awarded to the opposite team.
7. Prizes shall be awarded as follows –
 - 1st prize to highest scorer holding the blue score card and yellow score card per session respectively.
 - 2nd prize to second highest scorer holding the blue score card and yellow score card per session respectively.
 - Overall 1st prize to the highest merged score from session one and two holding the blue score card and yellow score card respectively.

- Overall 2nd prize to the second highest merged score from session one and two holding the blue score card and yellow score card respectively.

Please note – If any player has already won a prize, then that player is subjected to minus 10 points for the second session and minus 15 points for overall score. In case of a tie for ANY prize, all players concerned shall be asked to pick a card from a deck. The player with the highest card (where Ace is the highest and 2 is the lowest) shall be duly considered as the winner for that prize.

8. Game master's/officials/conveners' decision shall be final.
